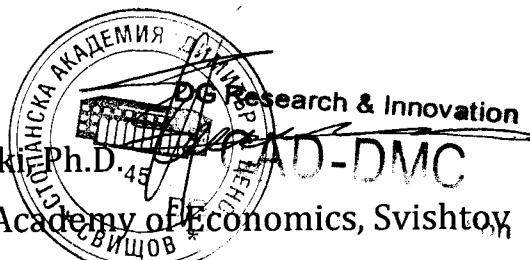
D. A. Tsenov Academy of Economics, Svishtov welcomes the European Commission's initiative and the European Union's policy to make research an attractive career.
