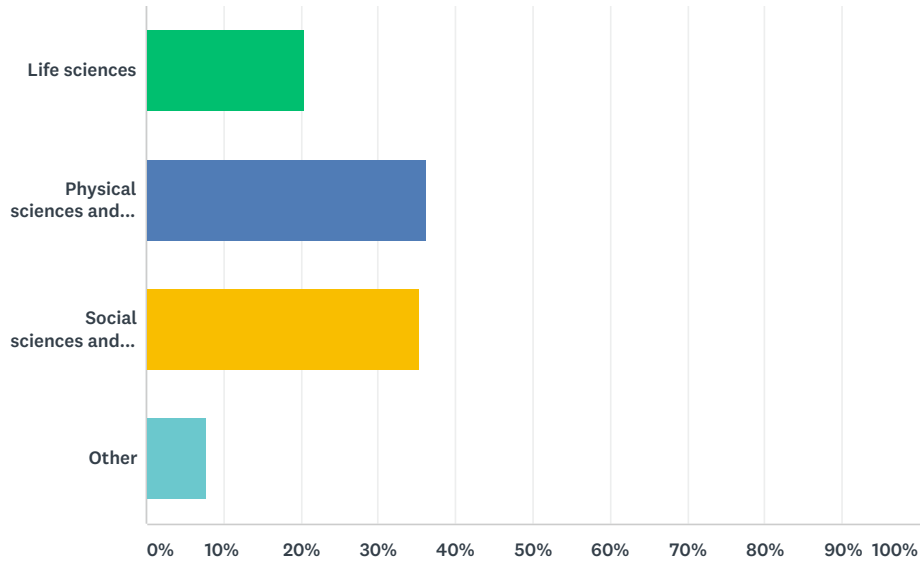

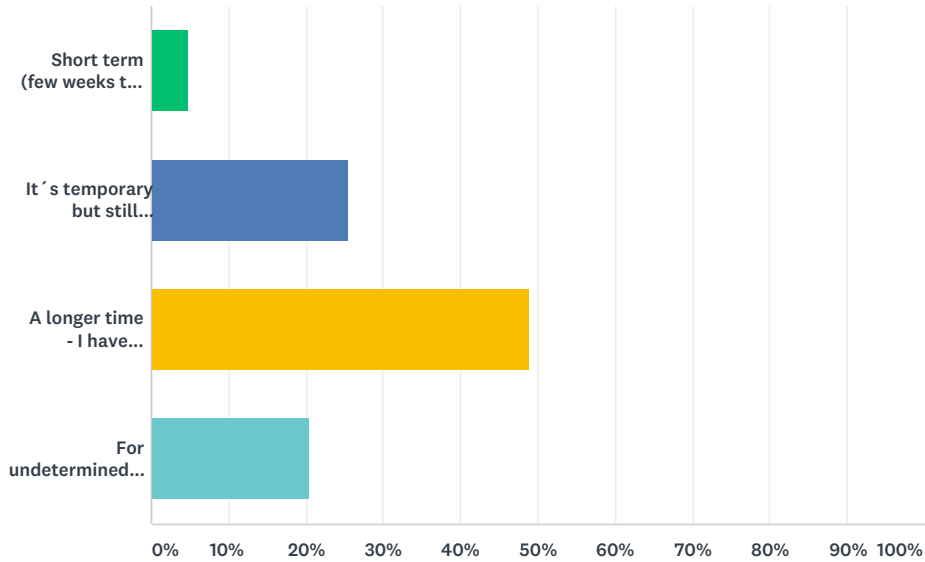

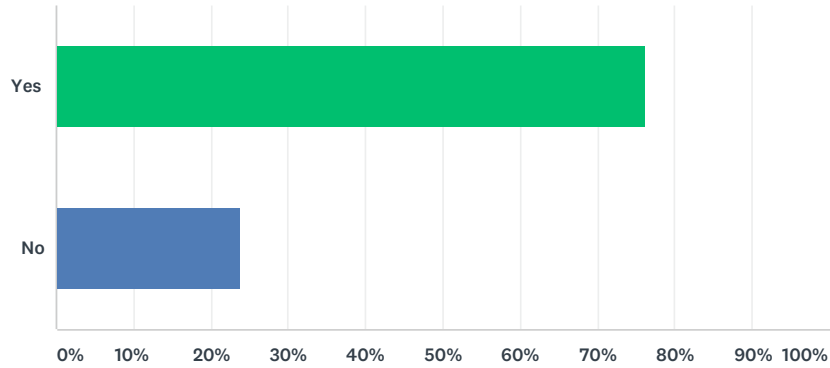

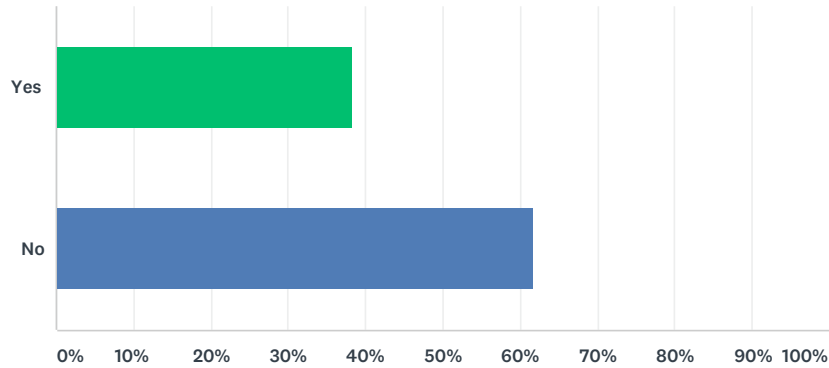

Q5 Have you ever become a beneficiary of these incentives and funding programmes?

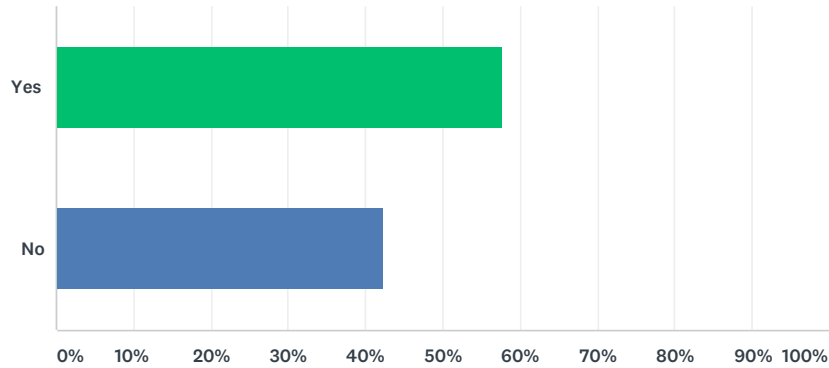

Q7 If you were aware of these incentives, do you feel like the criteria of these incentives target researchers like yourself?

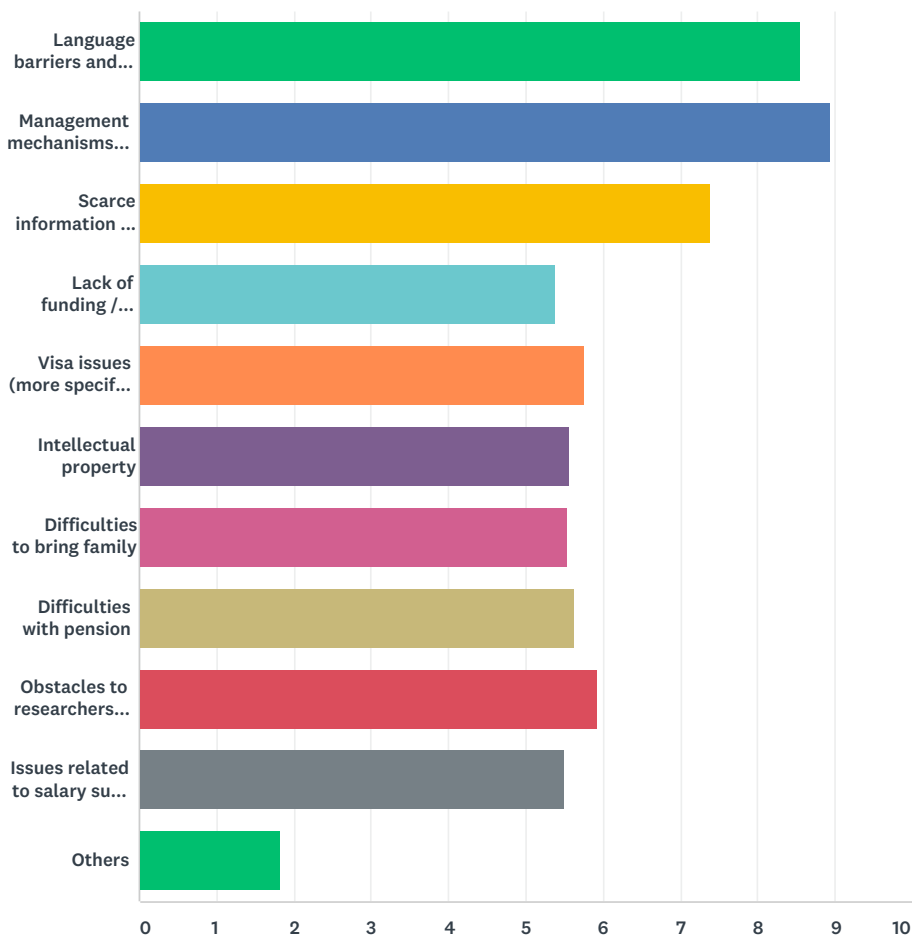

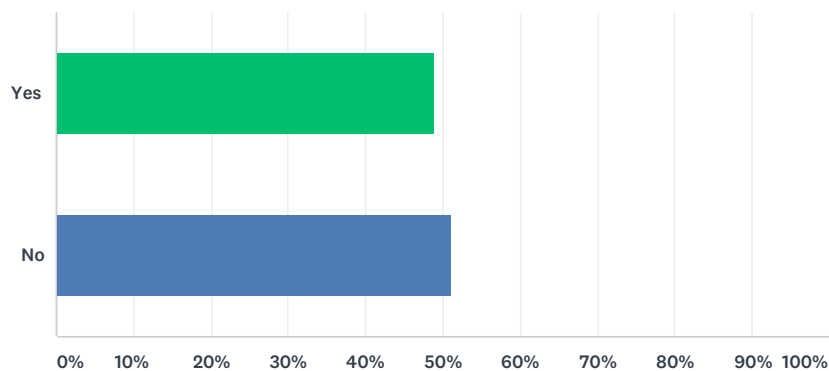

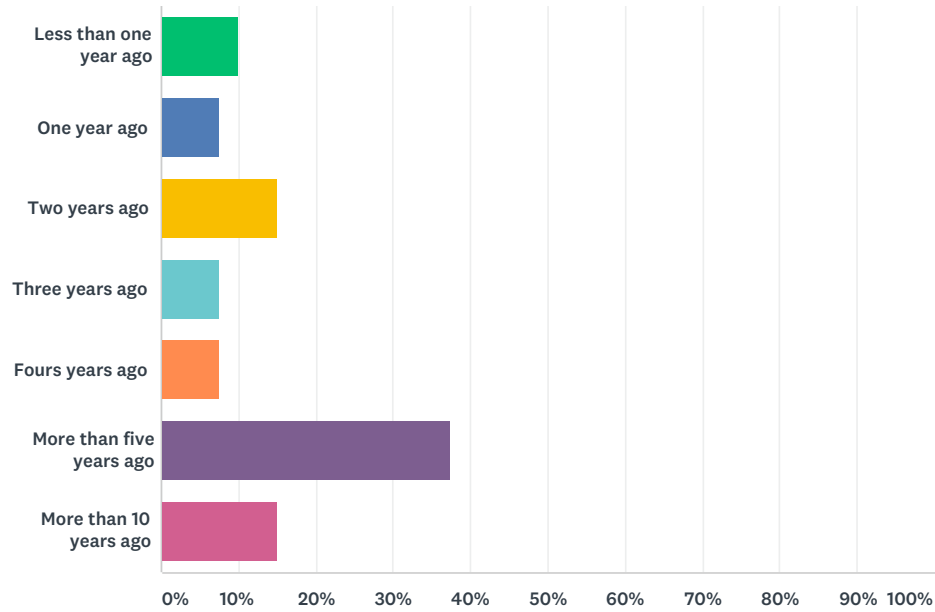

Q16 When did you start working at a Chinese university?

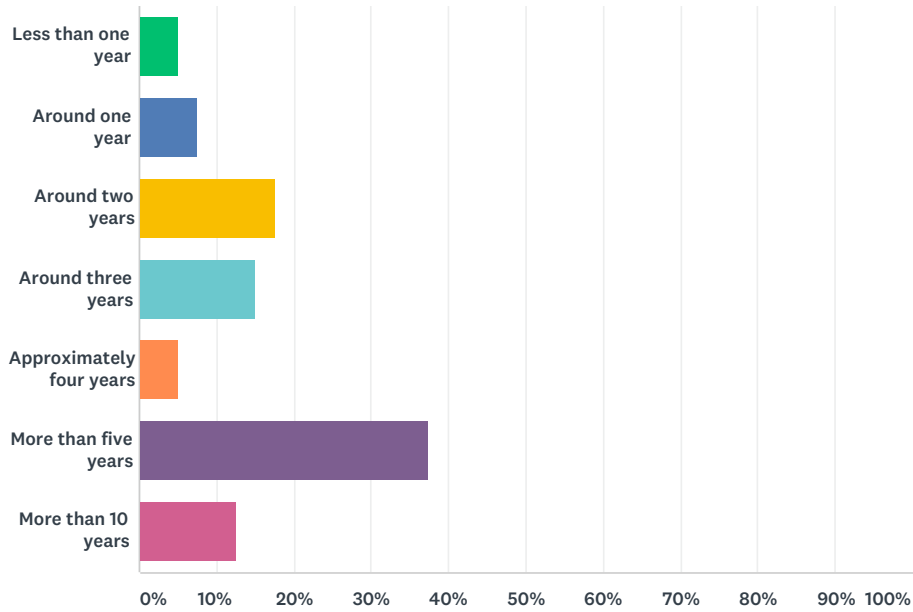

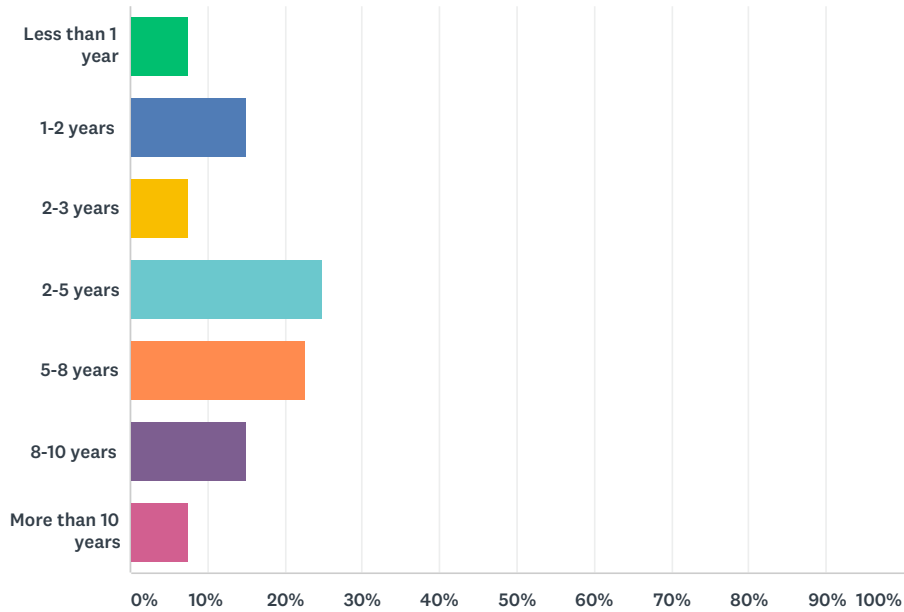

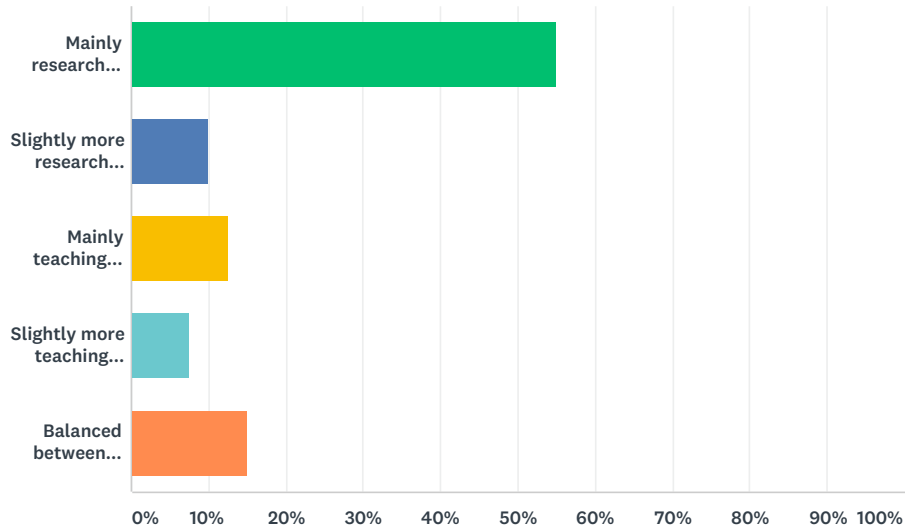

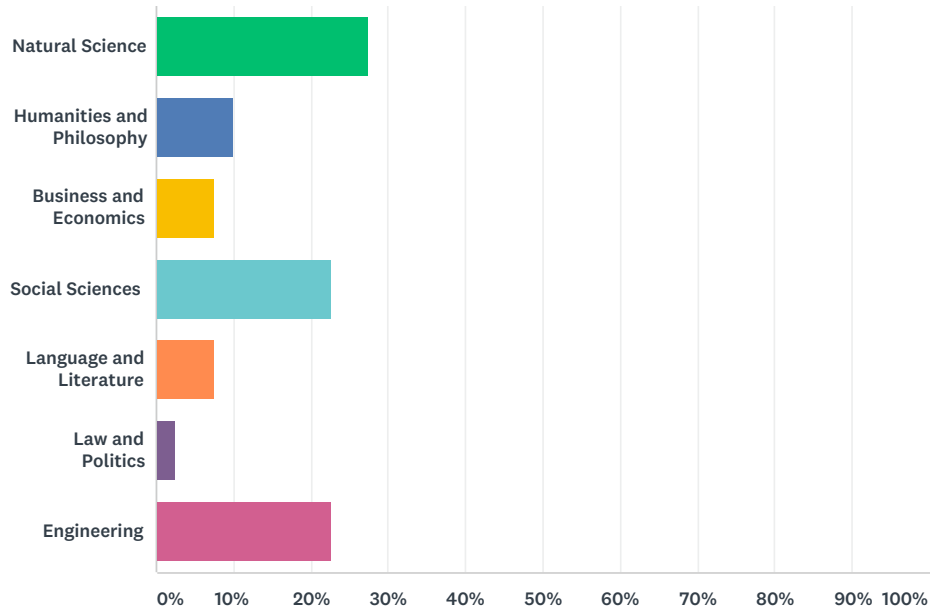

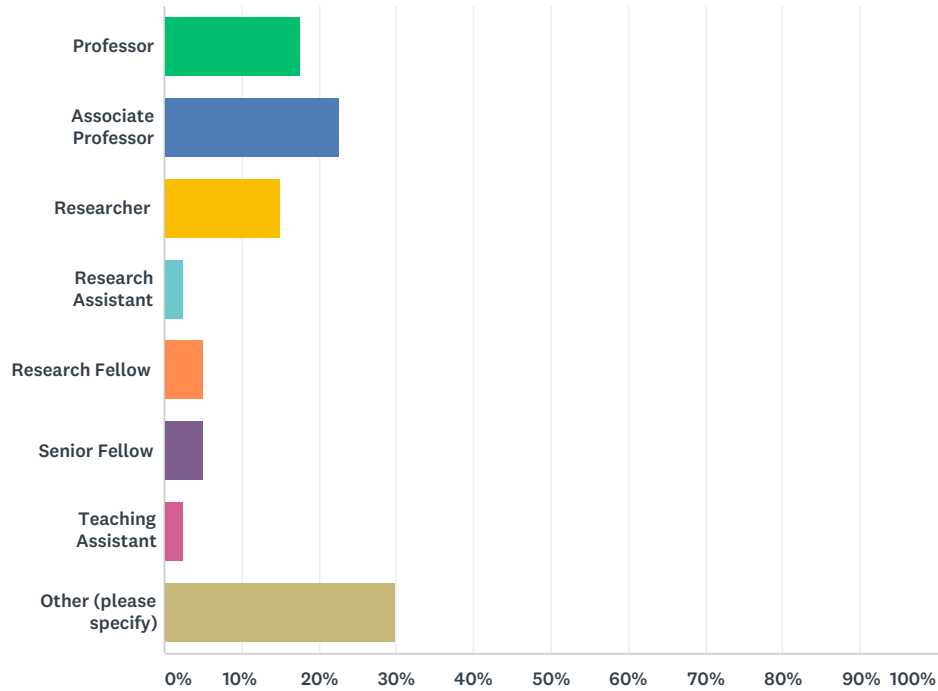

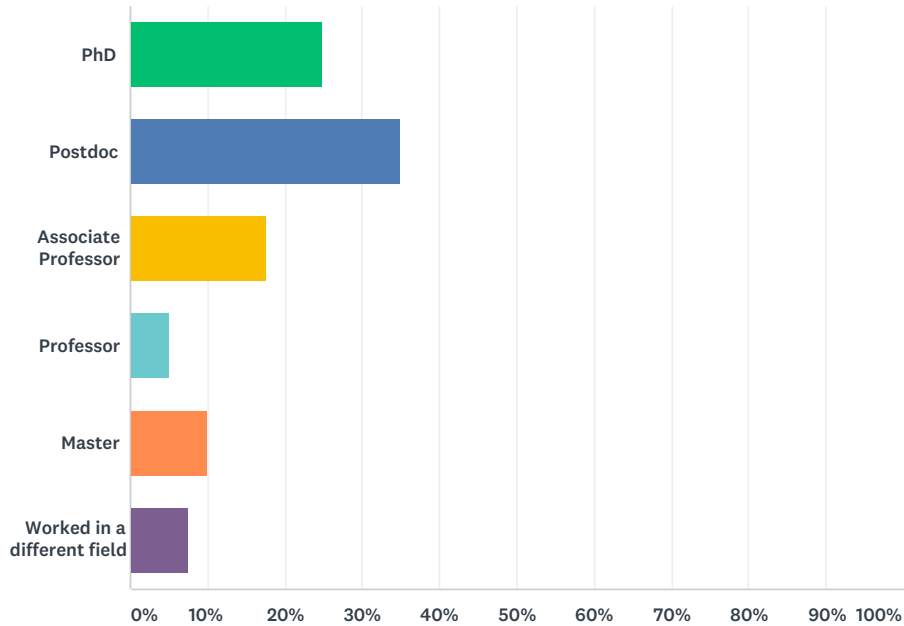

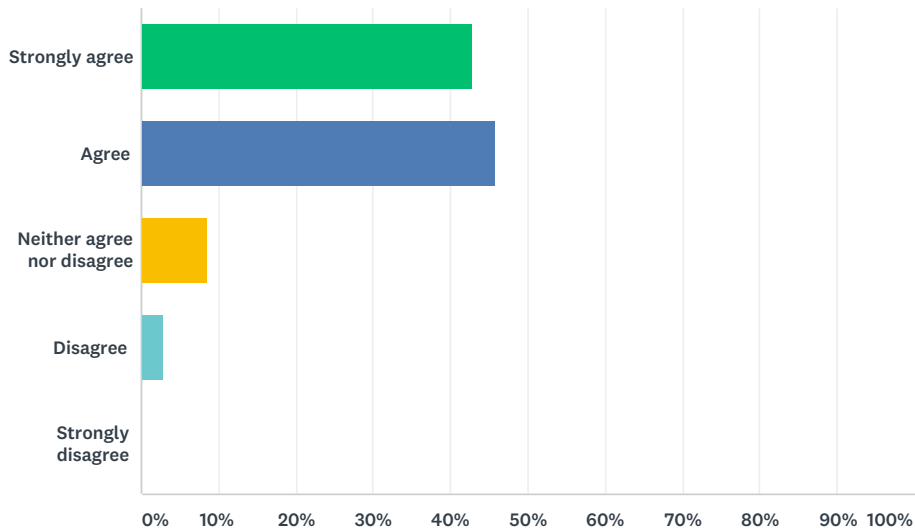

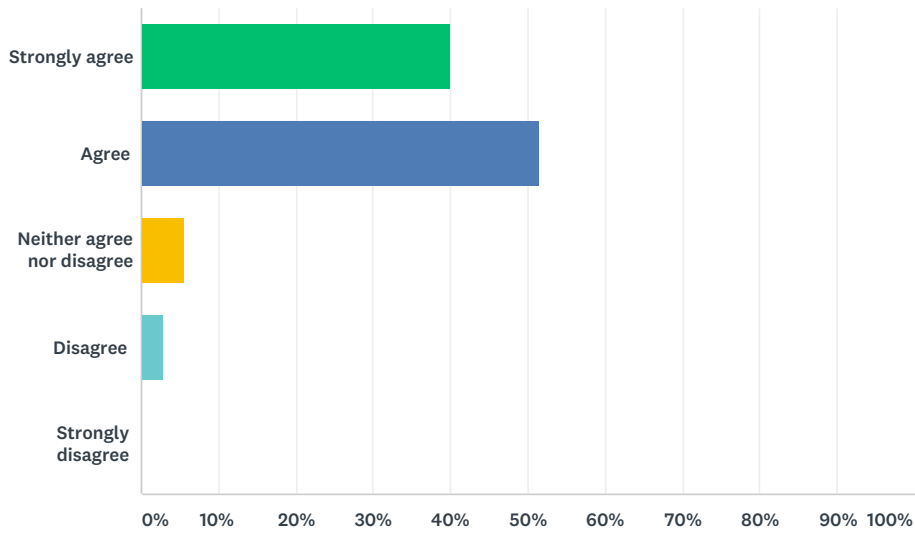

Q26 Do you agree that Chinese universities increased their international importance in the last ten years?

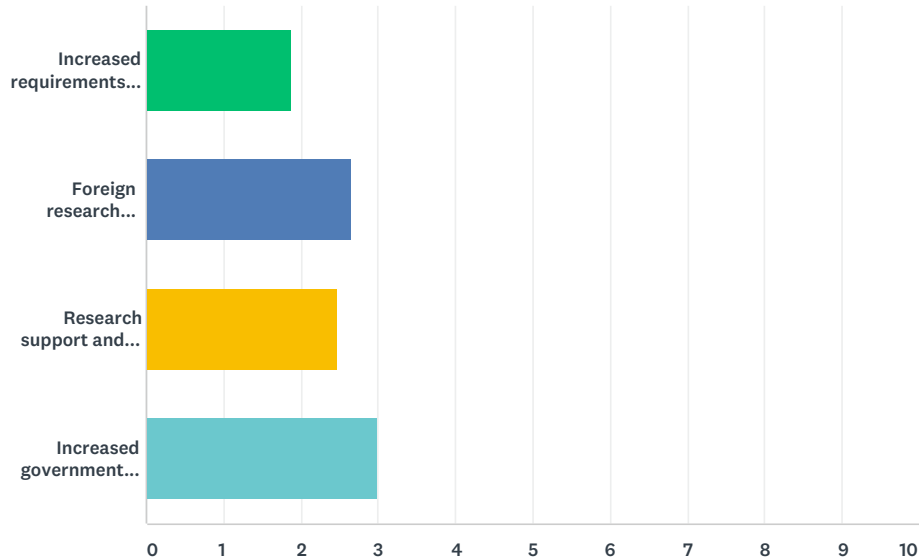

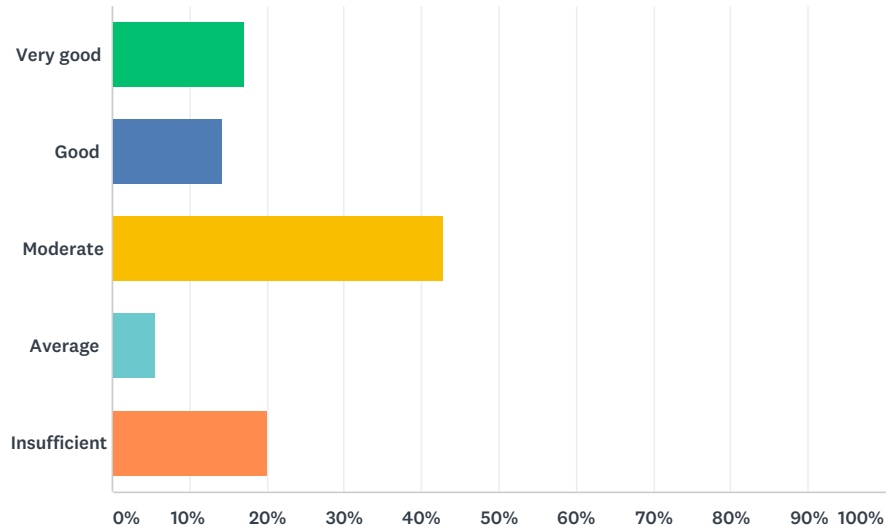

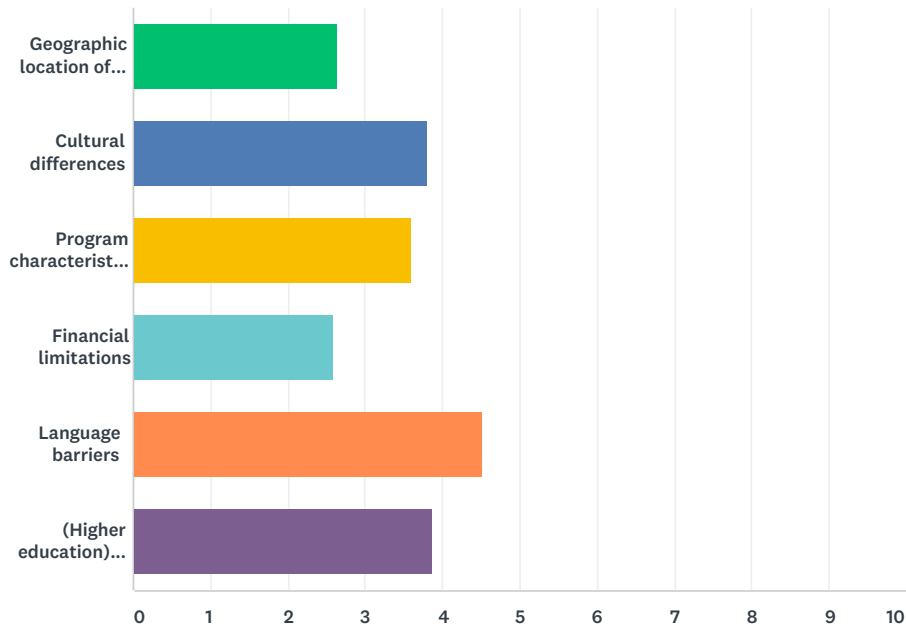

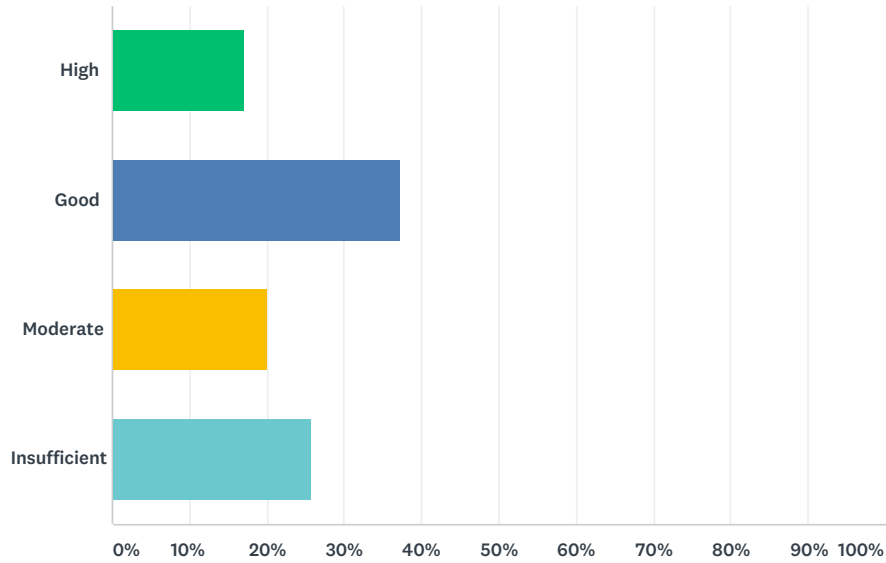

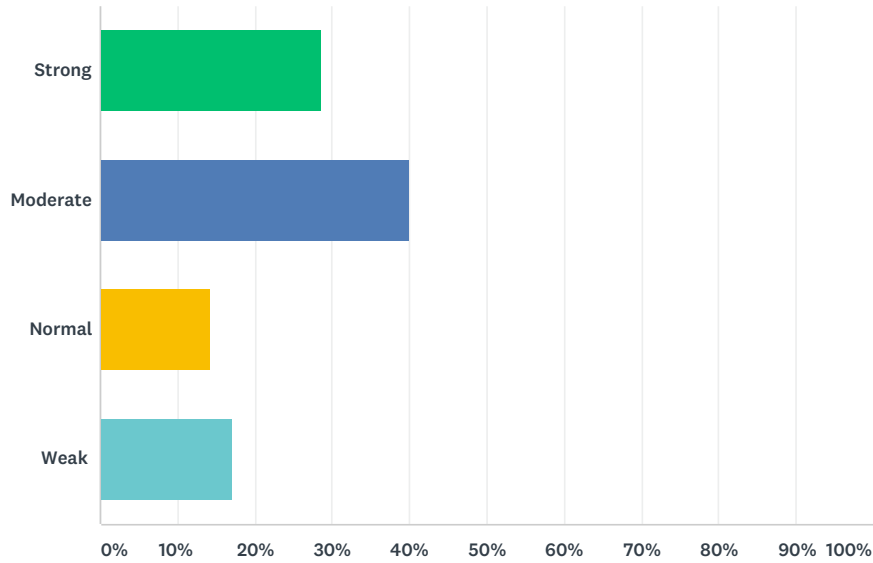

Q31 What is your perception of the impact of international factors in research on your subject area in China?

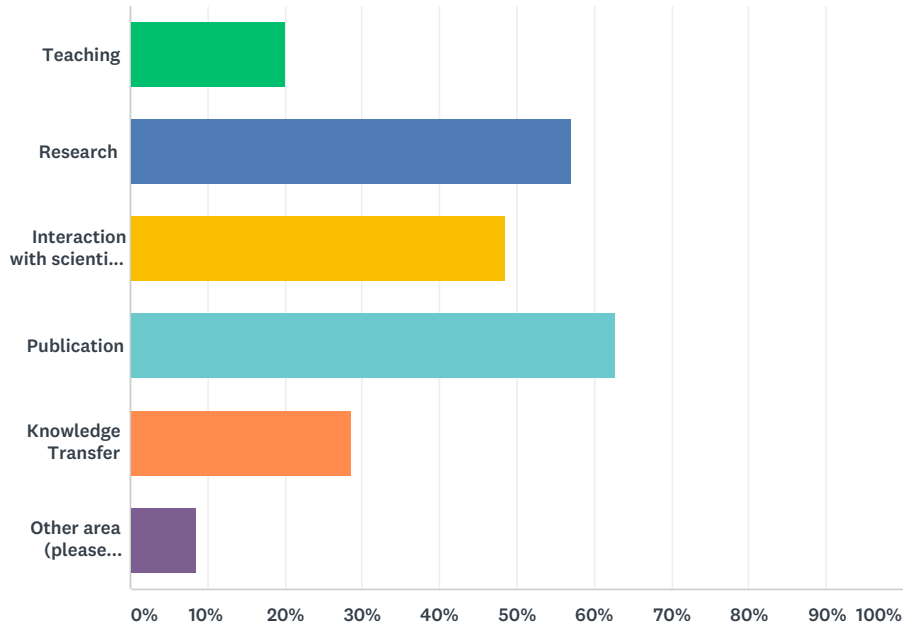

Q32 In which area do you perceive the level of internationalization to be strongest for your subject area in China? Please select up to 3 answers.

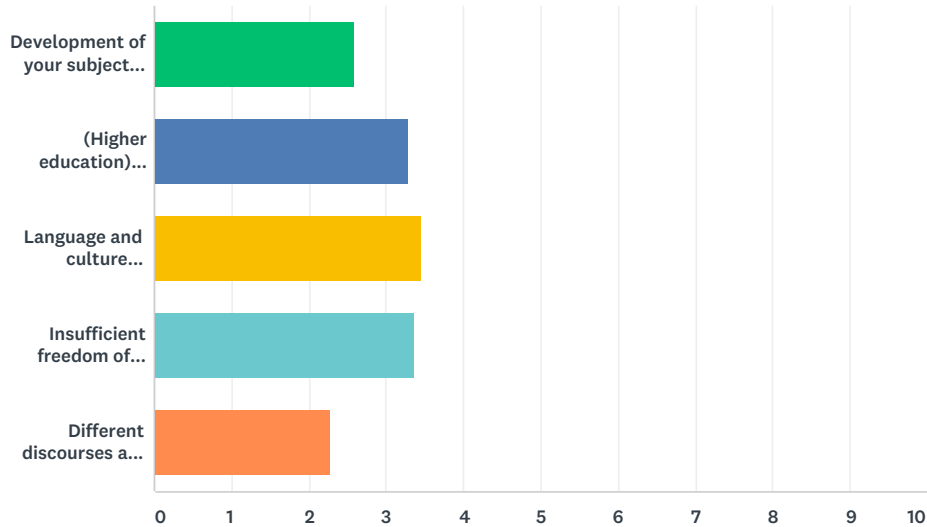

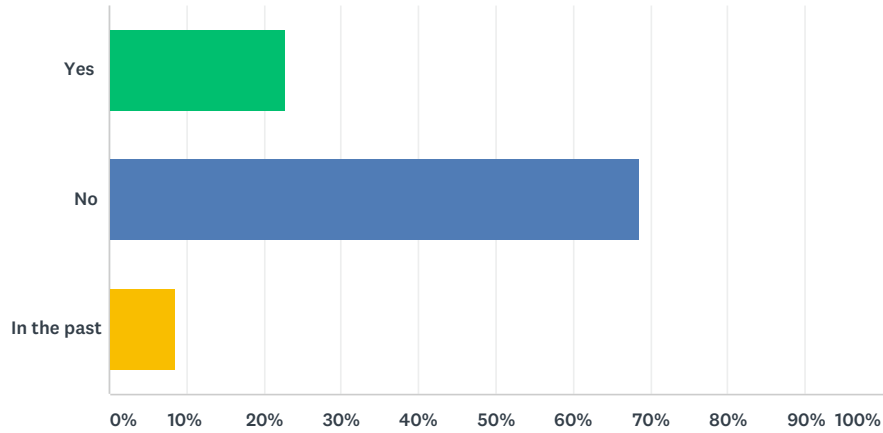

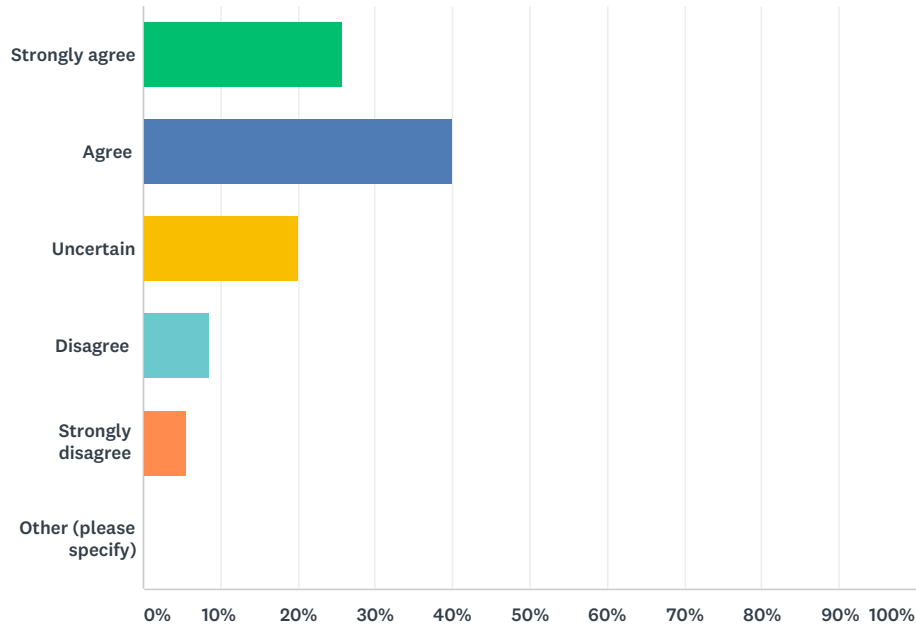

Q35 Do you think that the requirement to publish in international journals leads to a significant improvement of research quality?

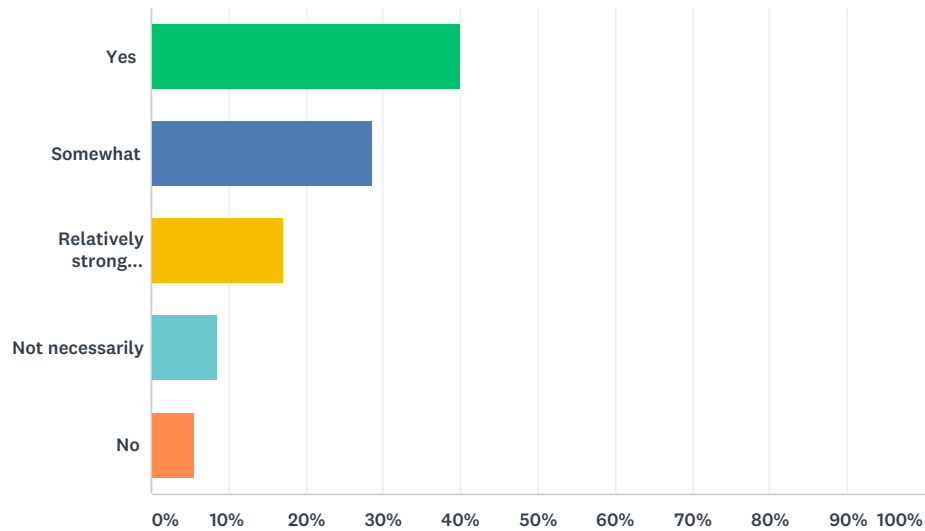

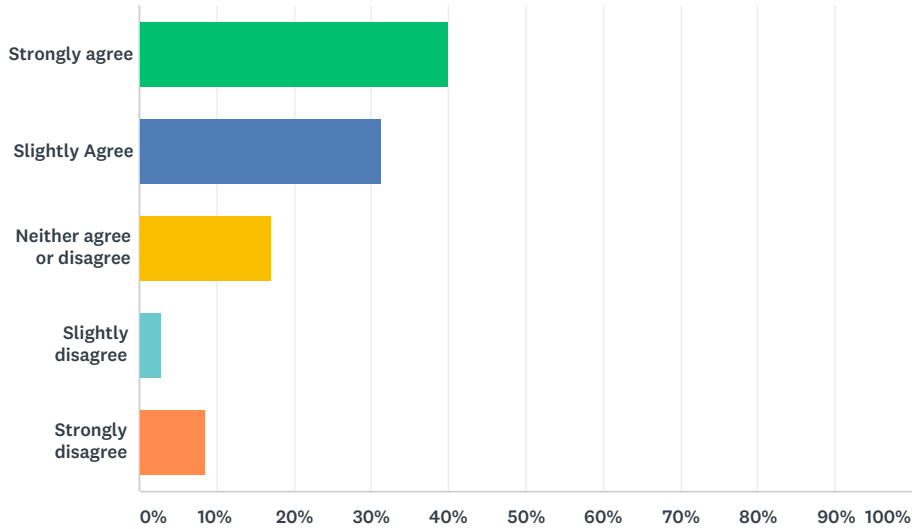

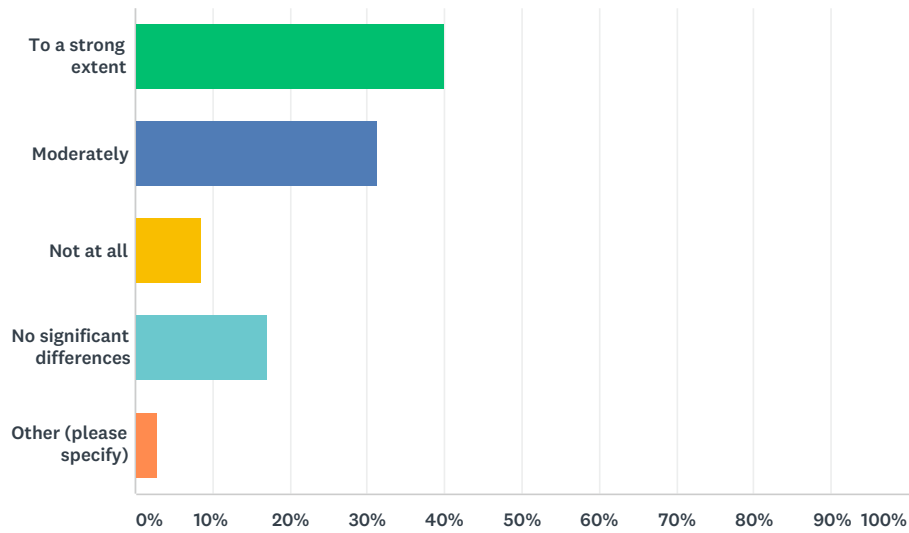

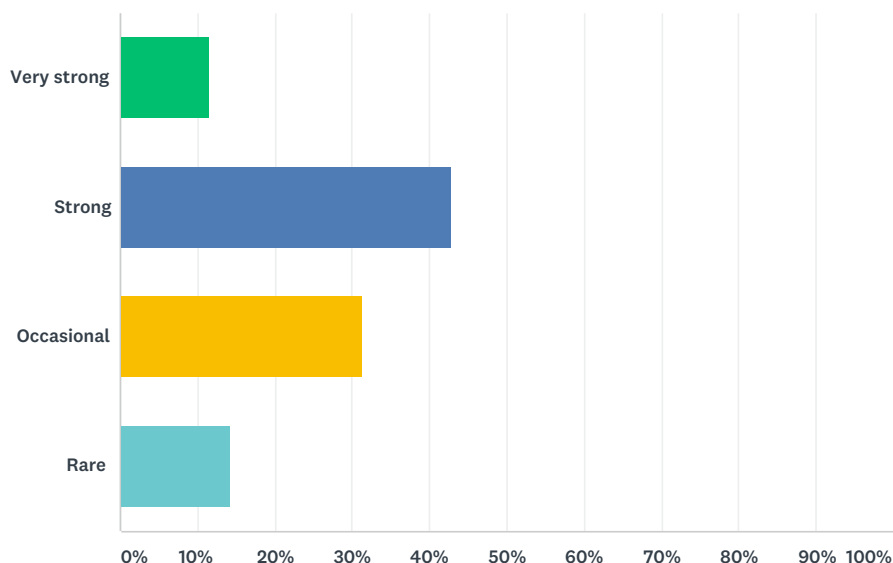

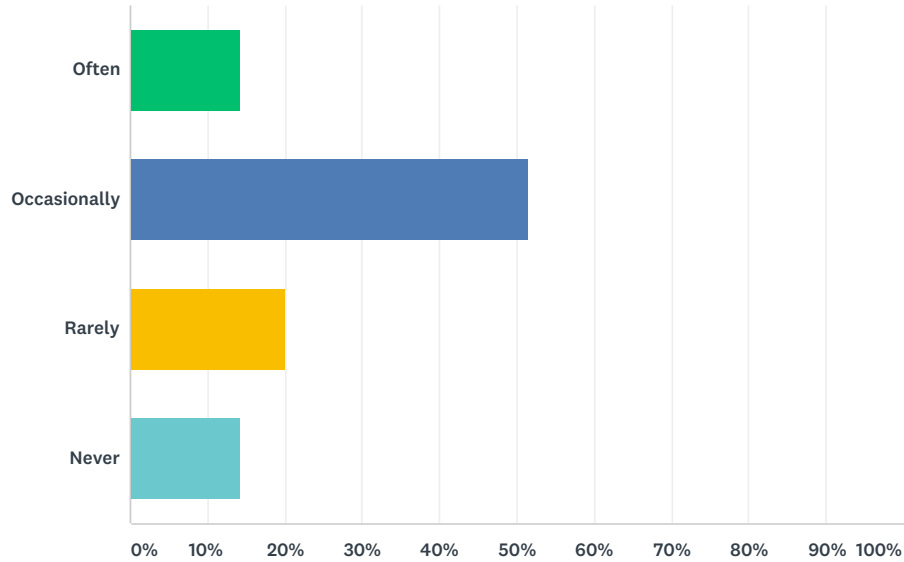

Q40 Because of your interaction with Chinese colleagues, do you encounter research ideas you otherwise would probably not come across?

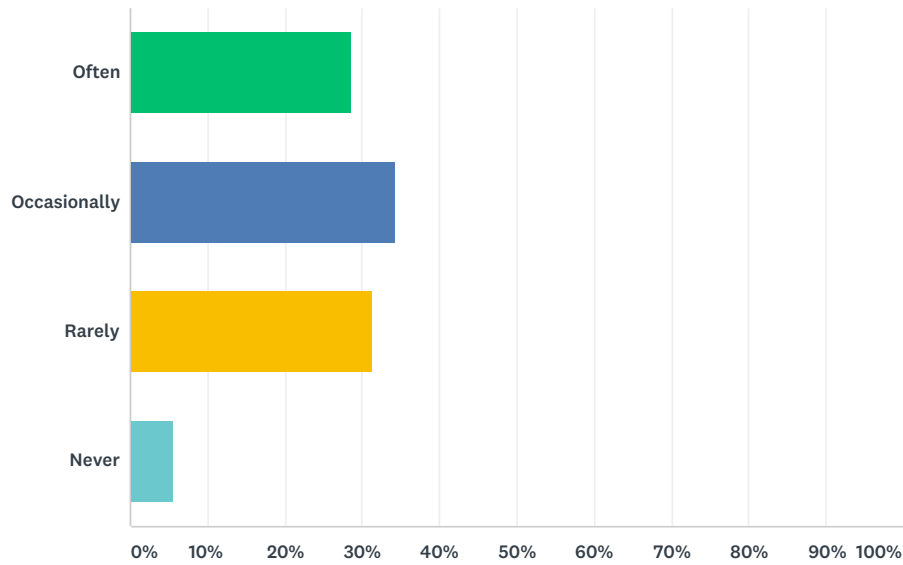

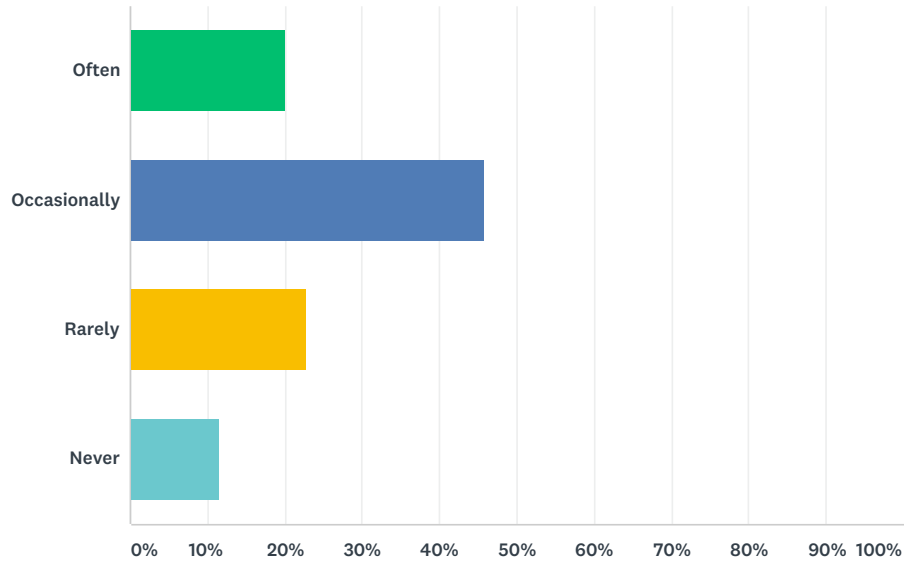

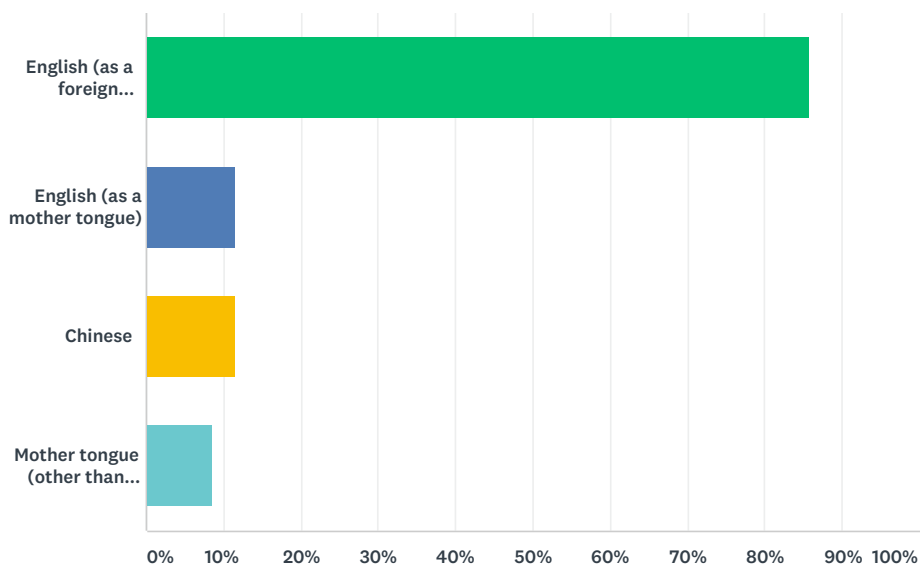

Q43 In which language have you published in China?

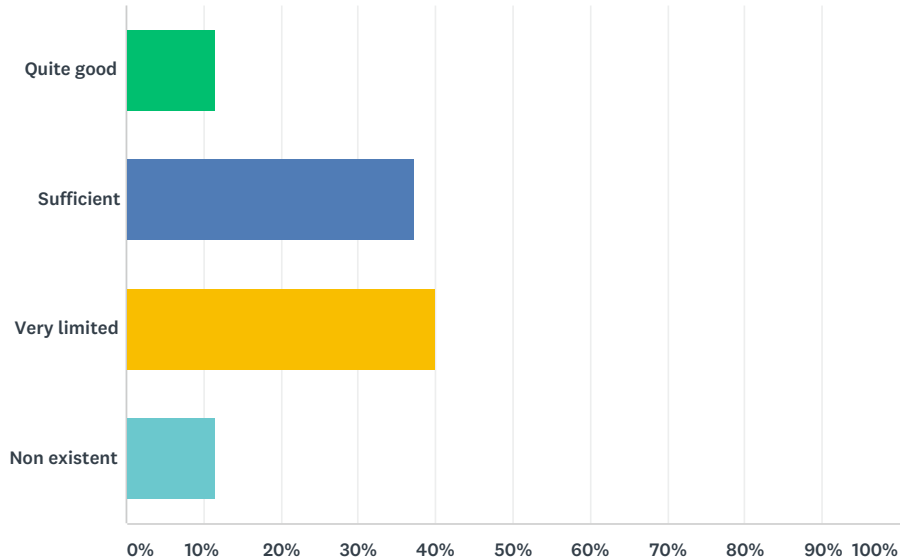

Q44 How do you evaluate the information for opportunities and applications for research funds provided to you (by your university) in China?

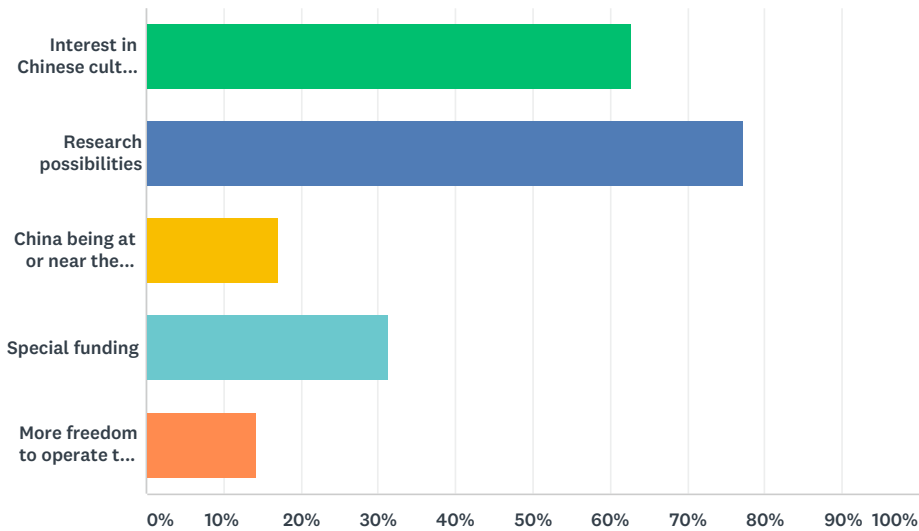

Q45 What have been your dominant motivations for working at a Chinese university? Select at most 3 options that apply

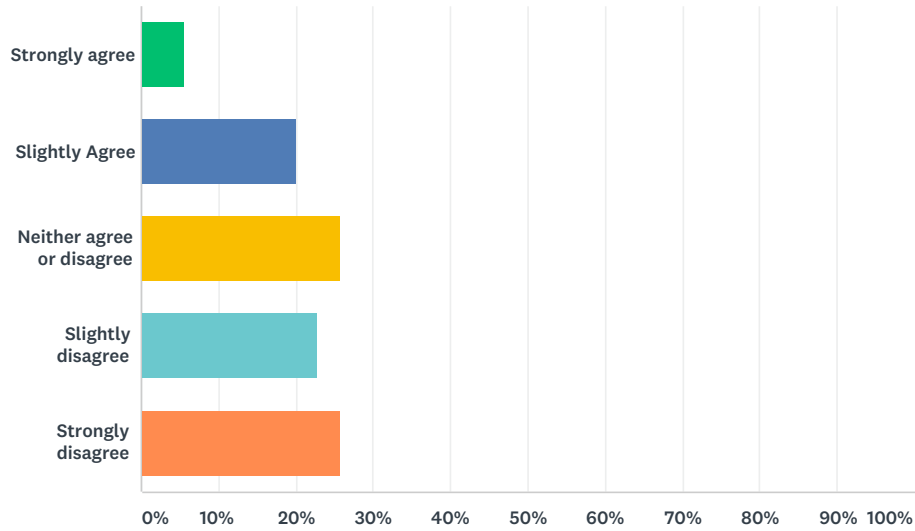

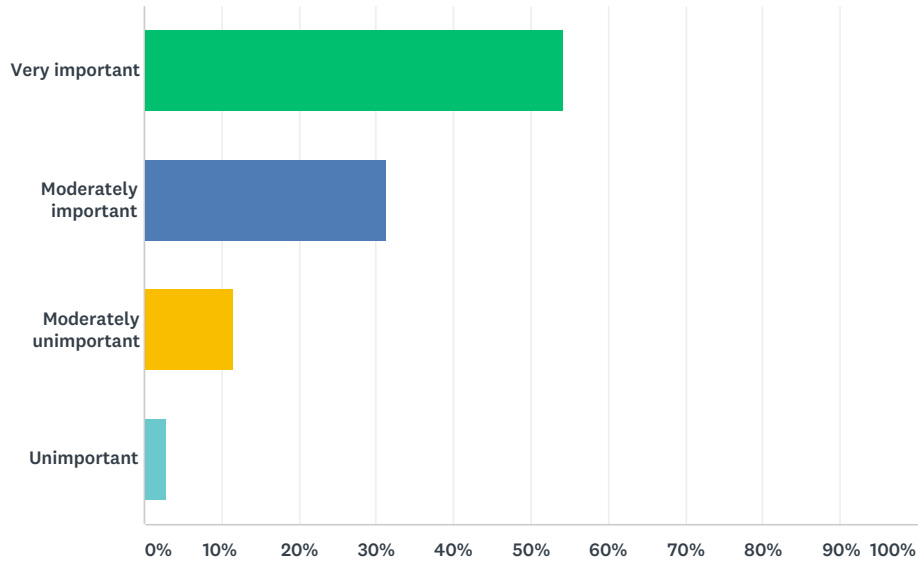

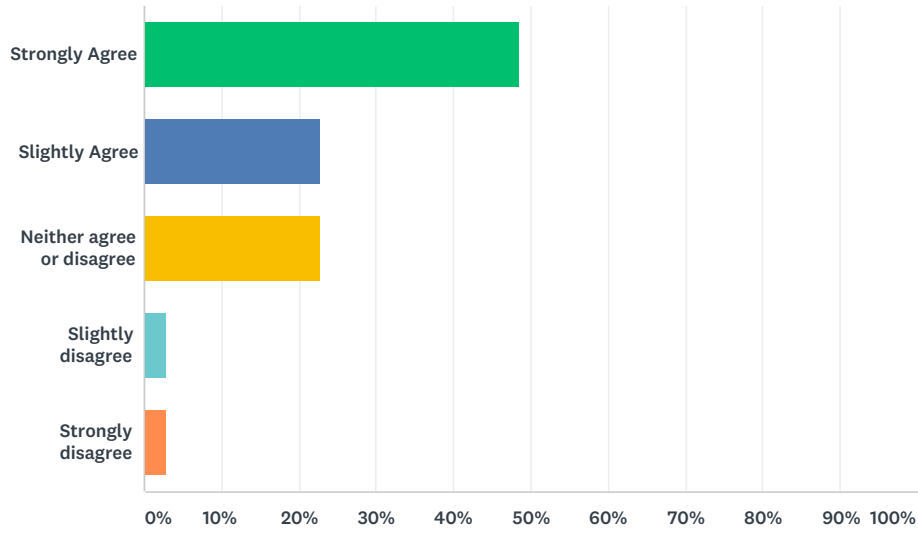

Q48 Would you all in all prefer to work at a European university?

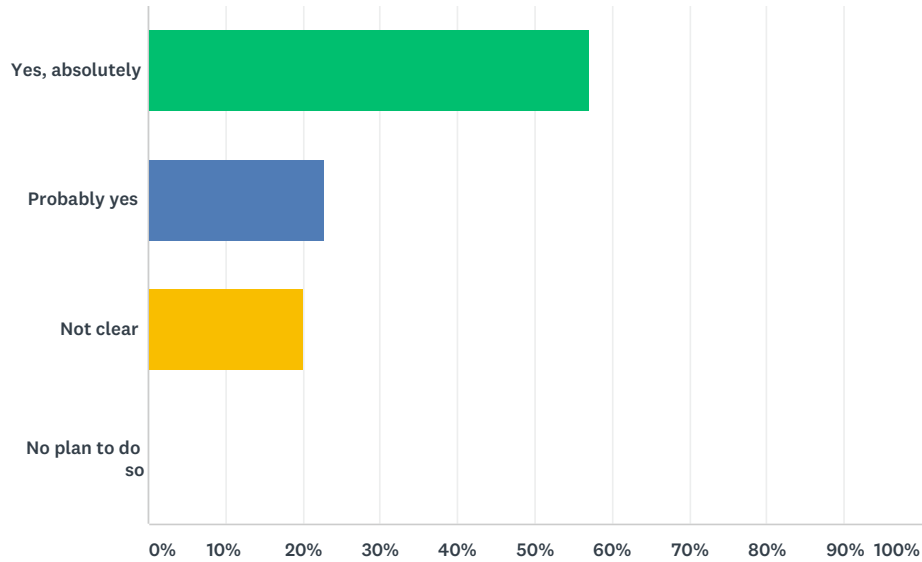

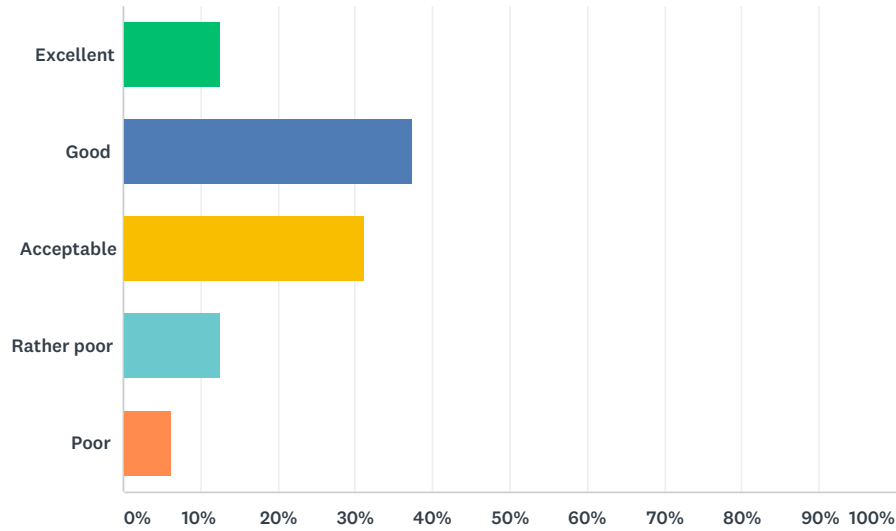

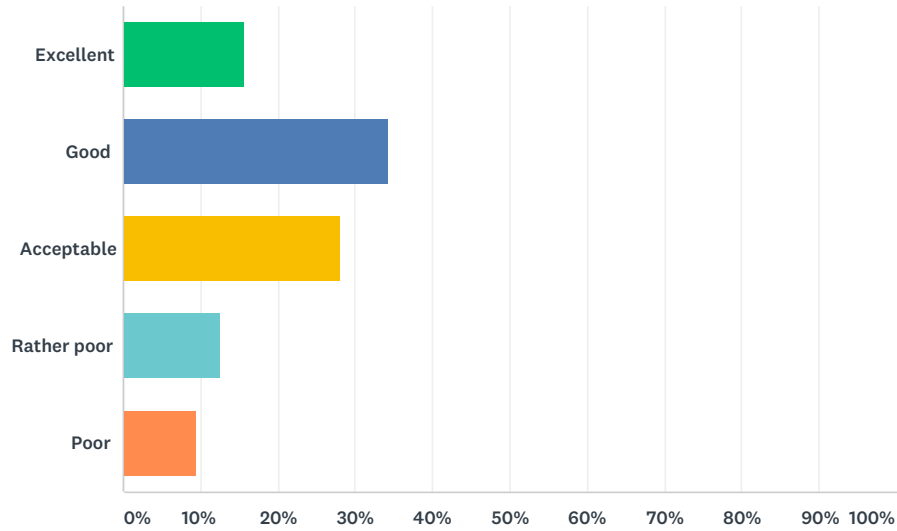

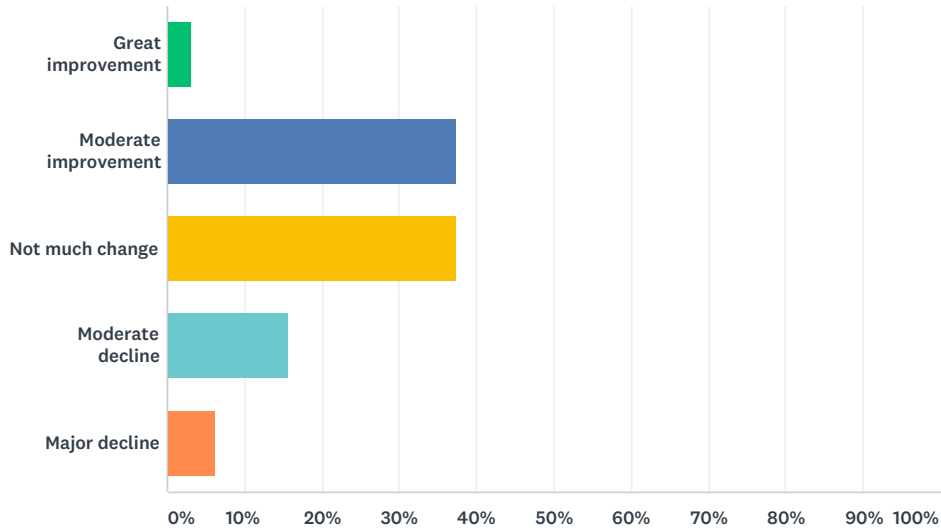

Q53 In the course of your stay in China has there been a change in your research and working conditions overall?

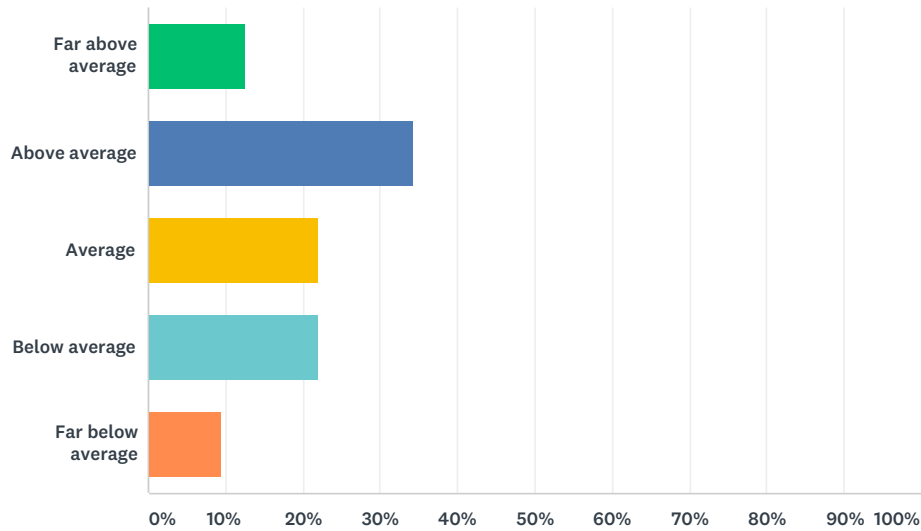

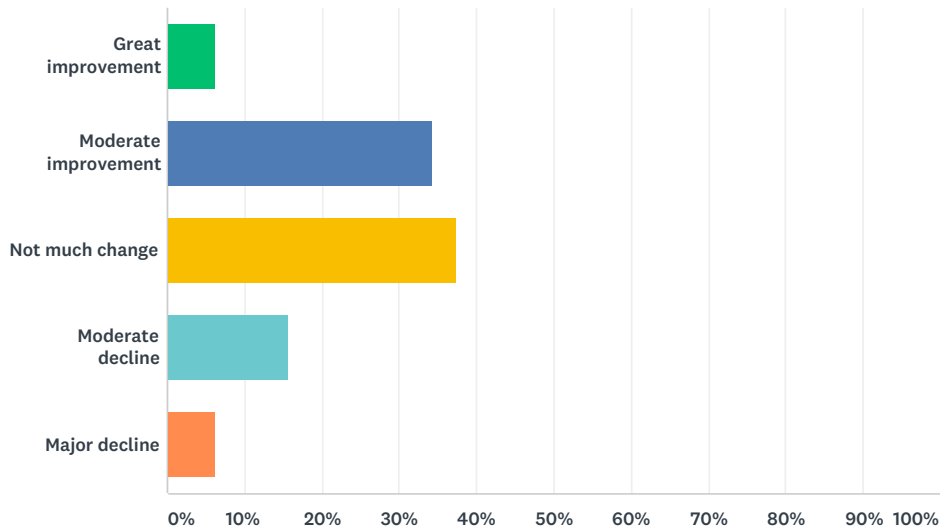

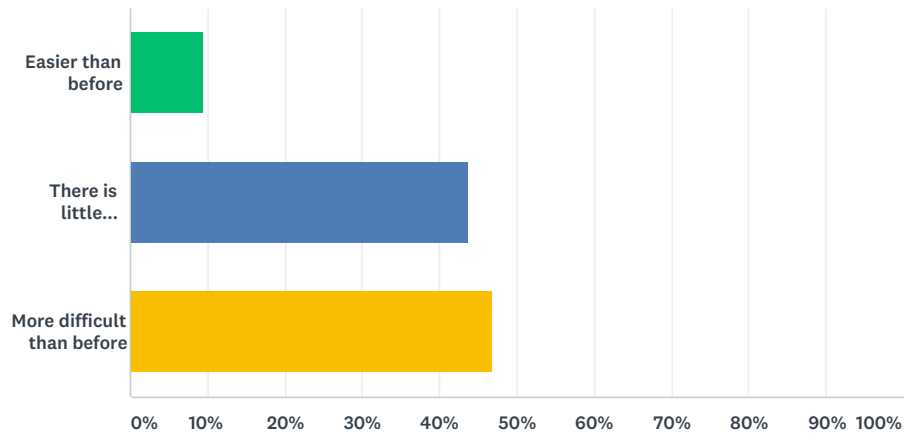

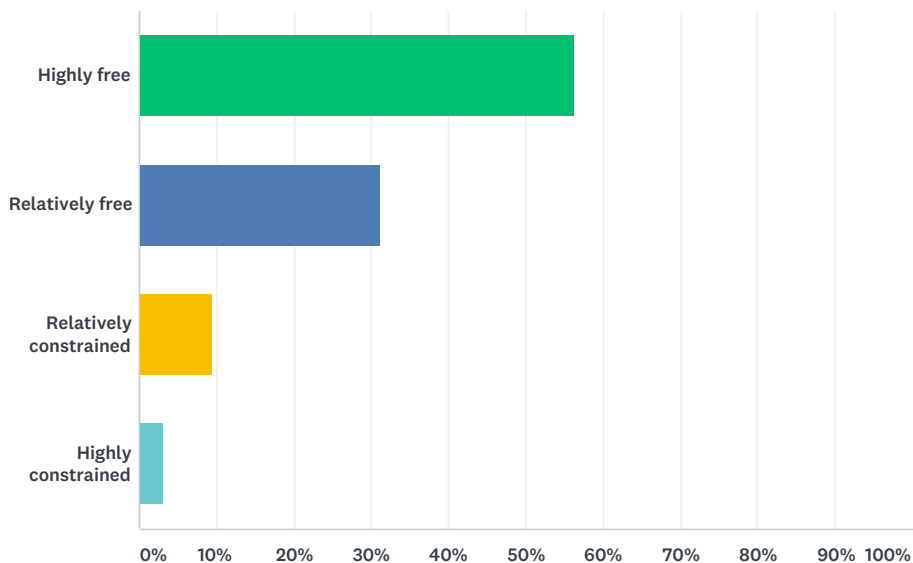

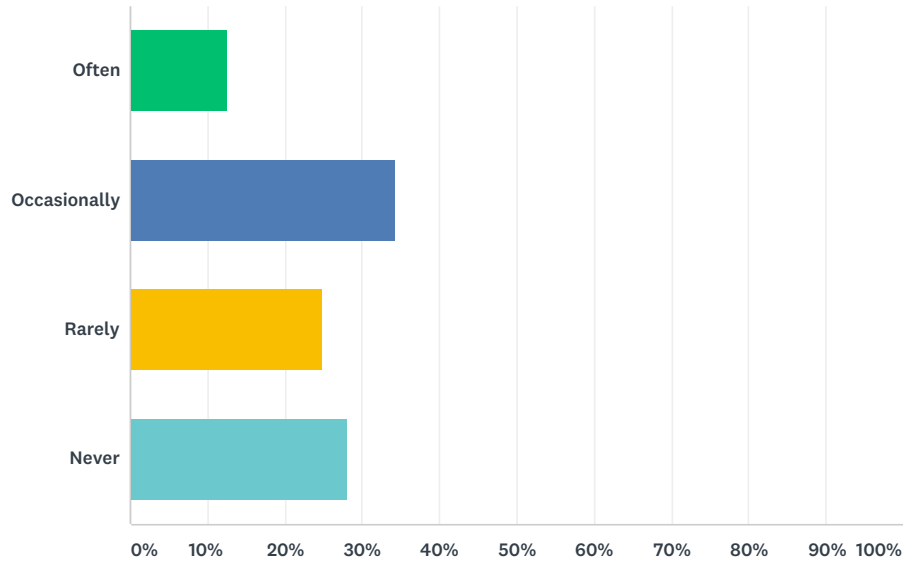

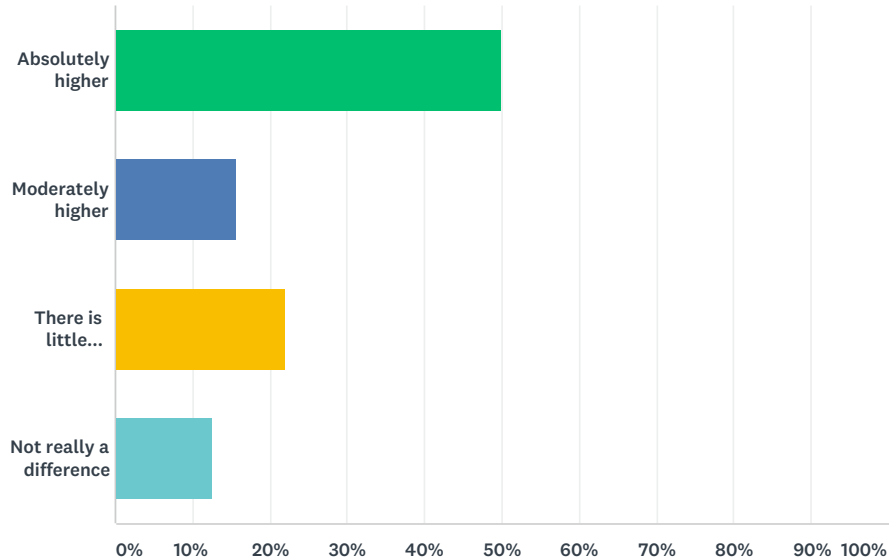

Q59 Do you think there is higher pressure in China than elsewhere for scientists to align their research with university or government programs or considerations?

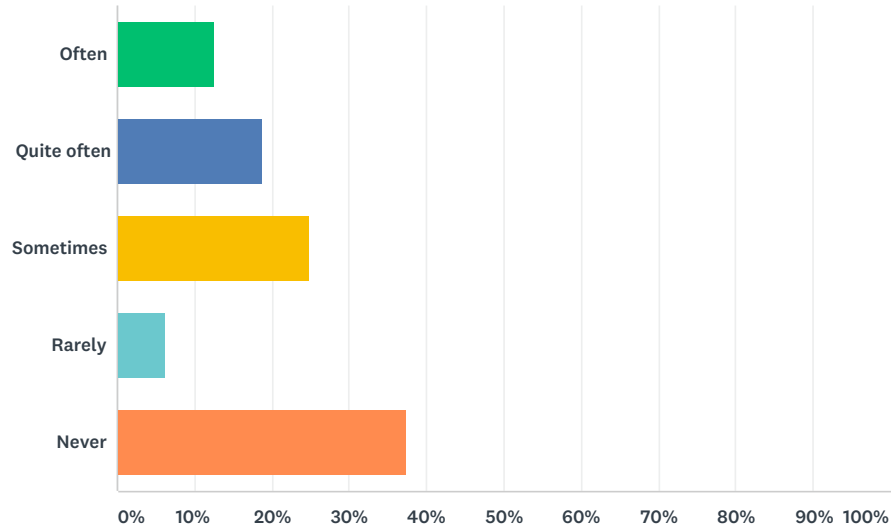

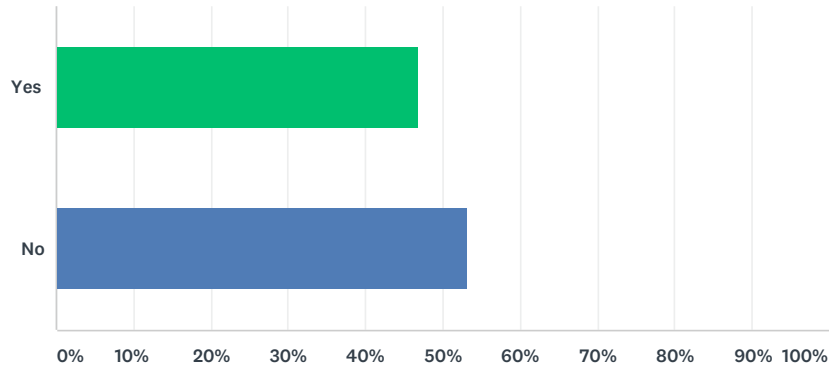

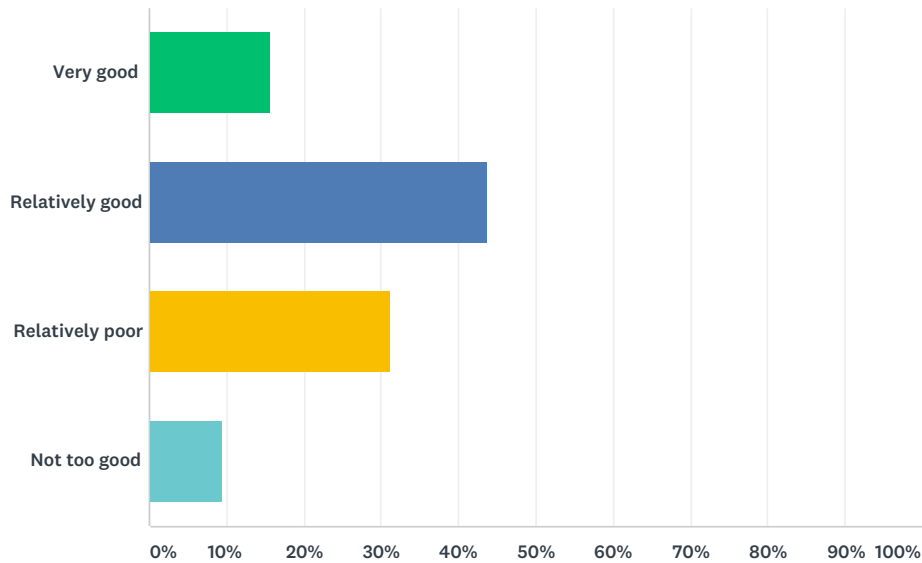

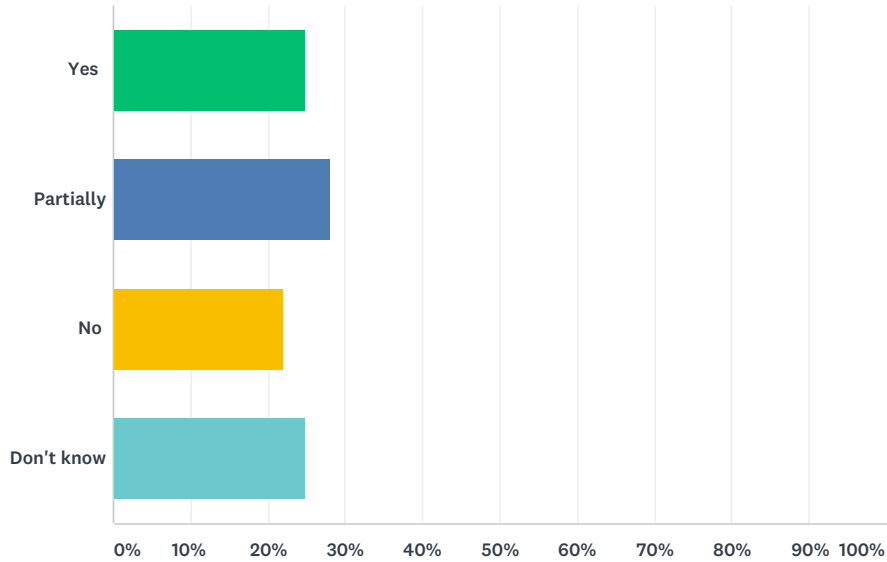

Q63 Have you had the feeling that research and projects regarding the development of "new" or special theories from China increased in the last 5 years?

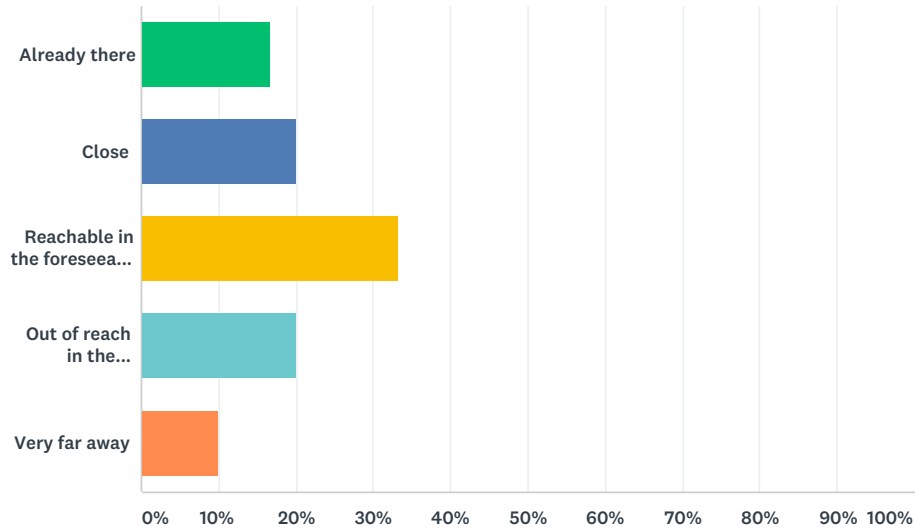

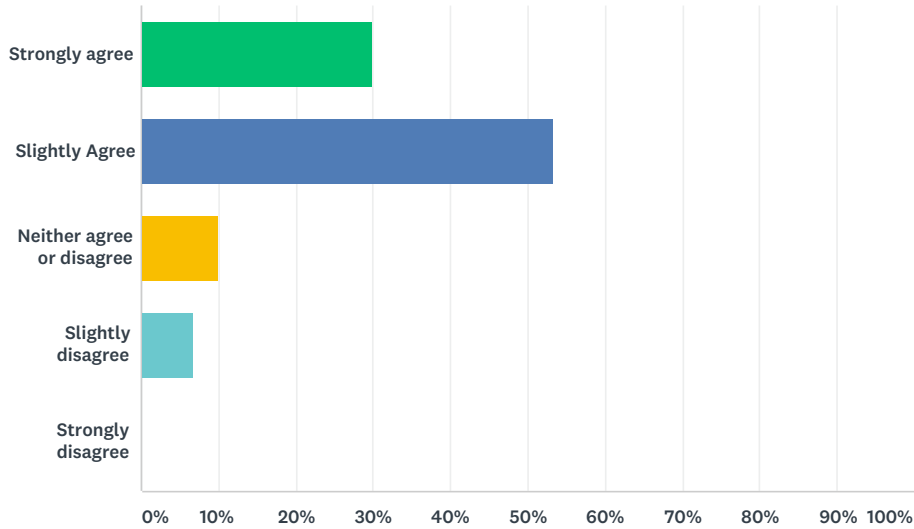

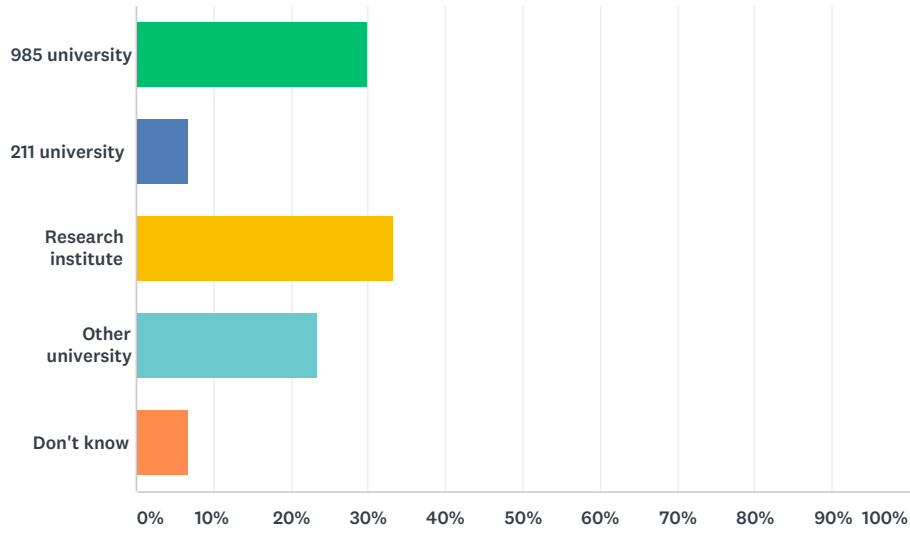

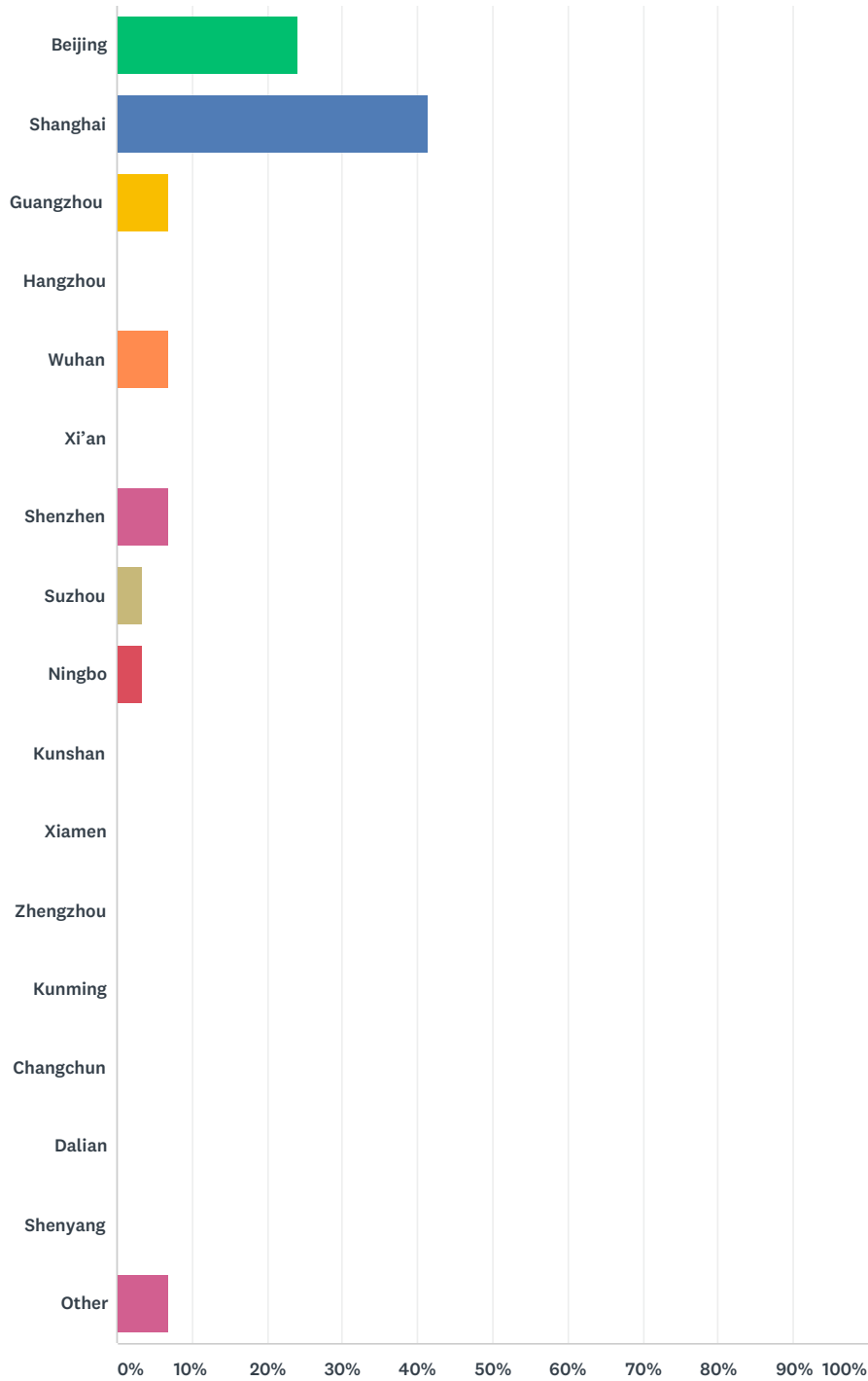

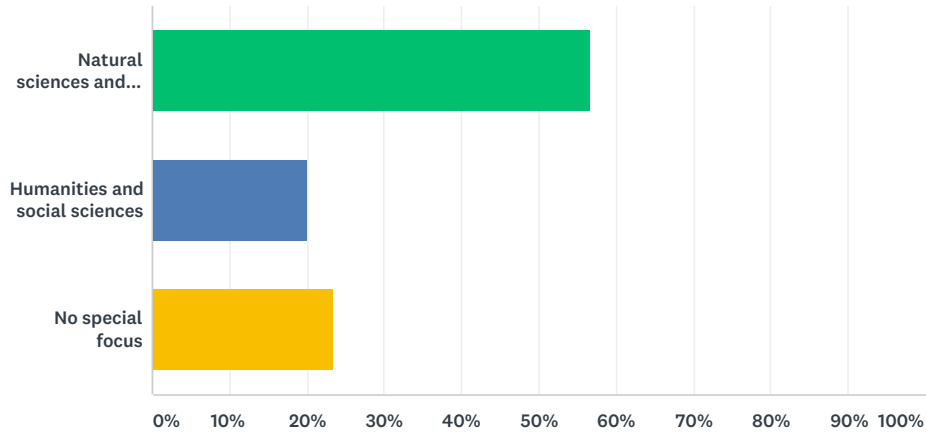
