



EURAXESS Survey of European Researchers in Japan

This survey, an initiative of EURAXESS Links Japan, intends to draw a precise picture of the community of European researchers based in Japan through a series of questions focused on the researchers' current professional situation in Japan and expectations for cooperation or mobility opportunities to Europe.

Researchers from the 42 countries included in the European research policies and based in Japan can participate. (EU-28 and: Iceland, Norway, Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, FYRO Macedonia, Montenegro, Serbia, Turkey, Israel, Moldova, Switzerland, Faroe Islands, Ukraine, and Tunisia)


