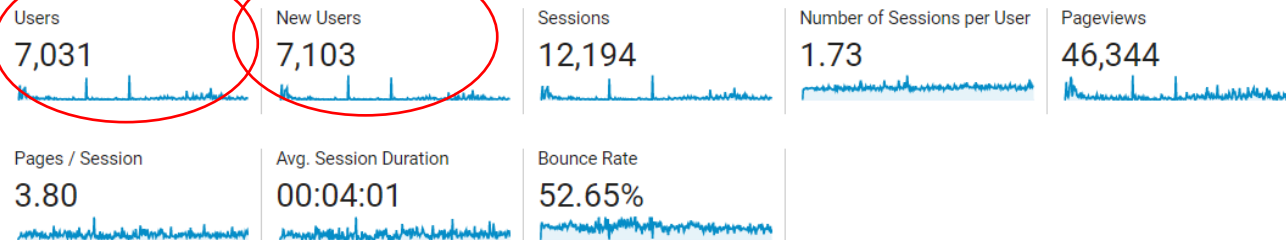
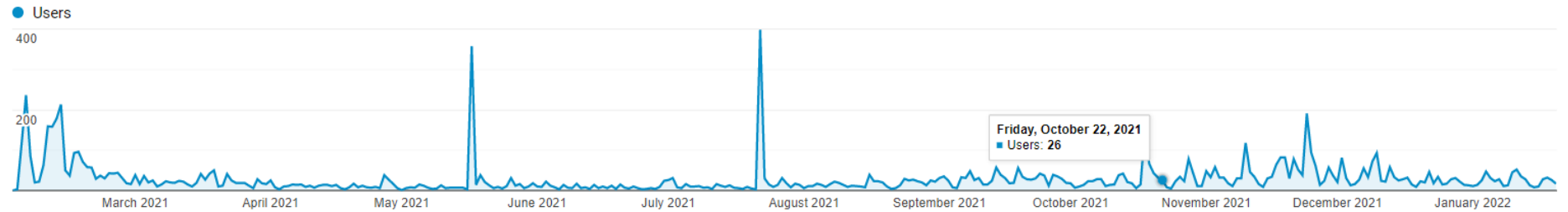

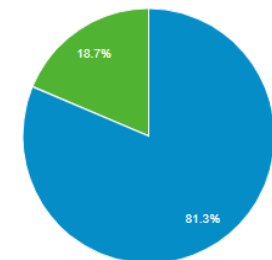

Hourly Day Week Month



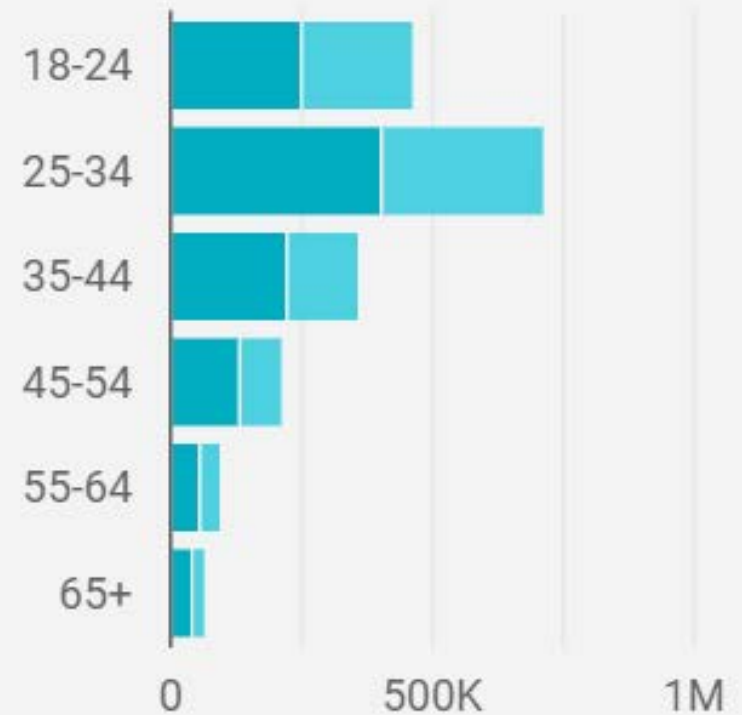
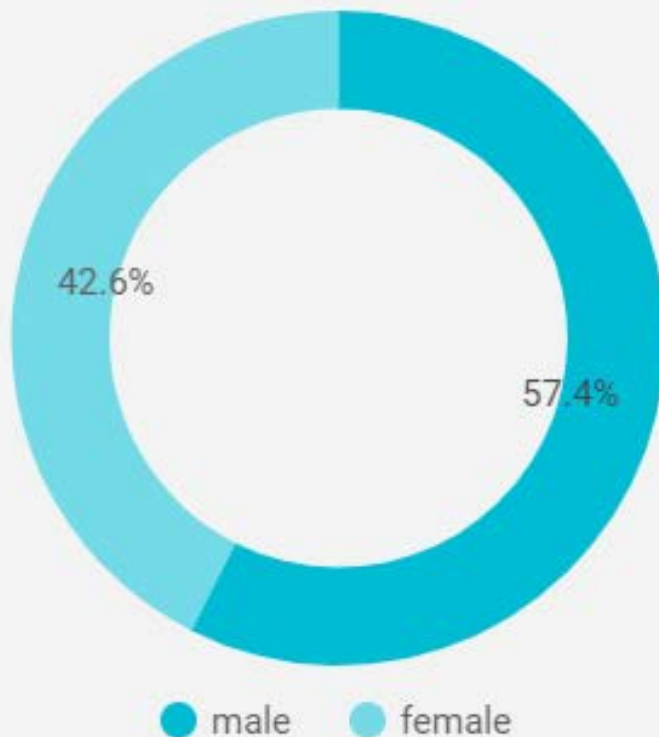
New Visitor Returning Visitor

Engagement by Age & Gender

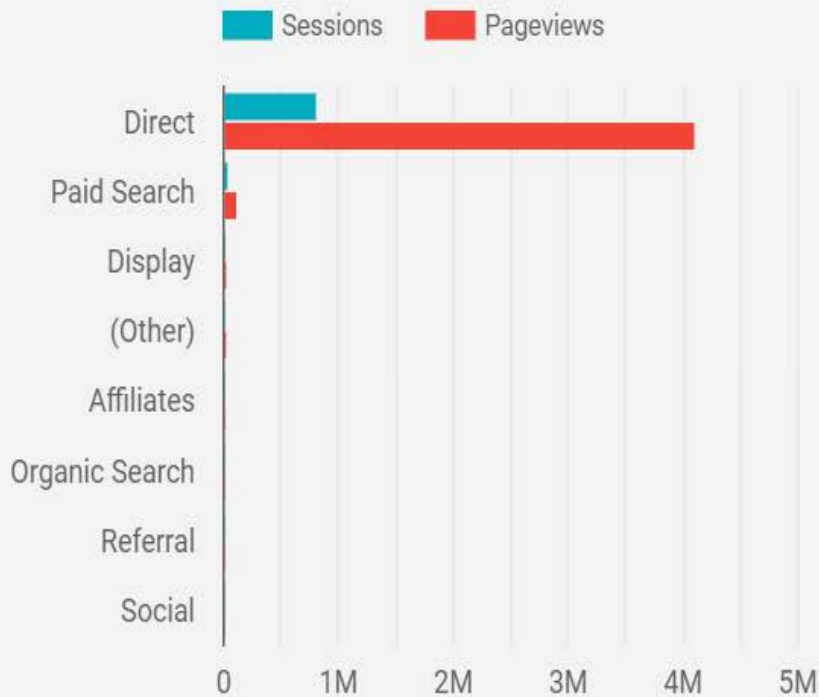

Which channels are driving engagement?

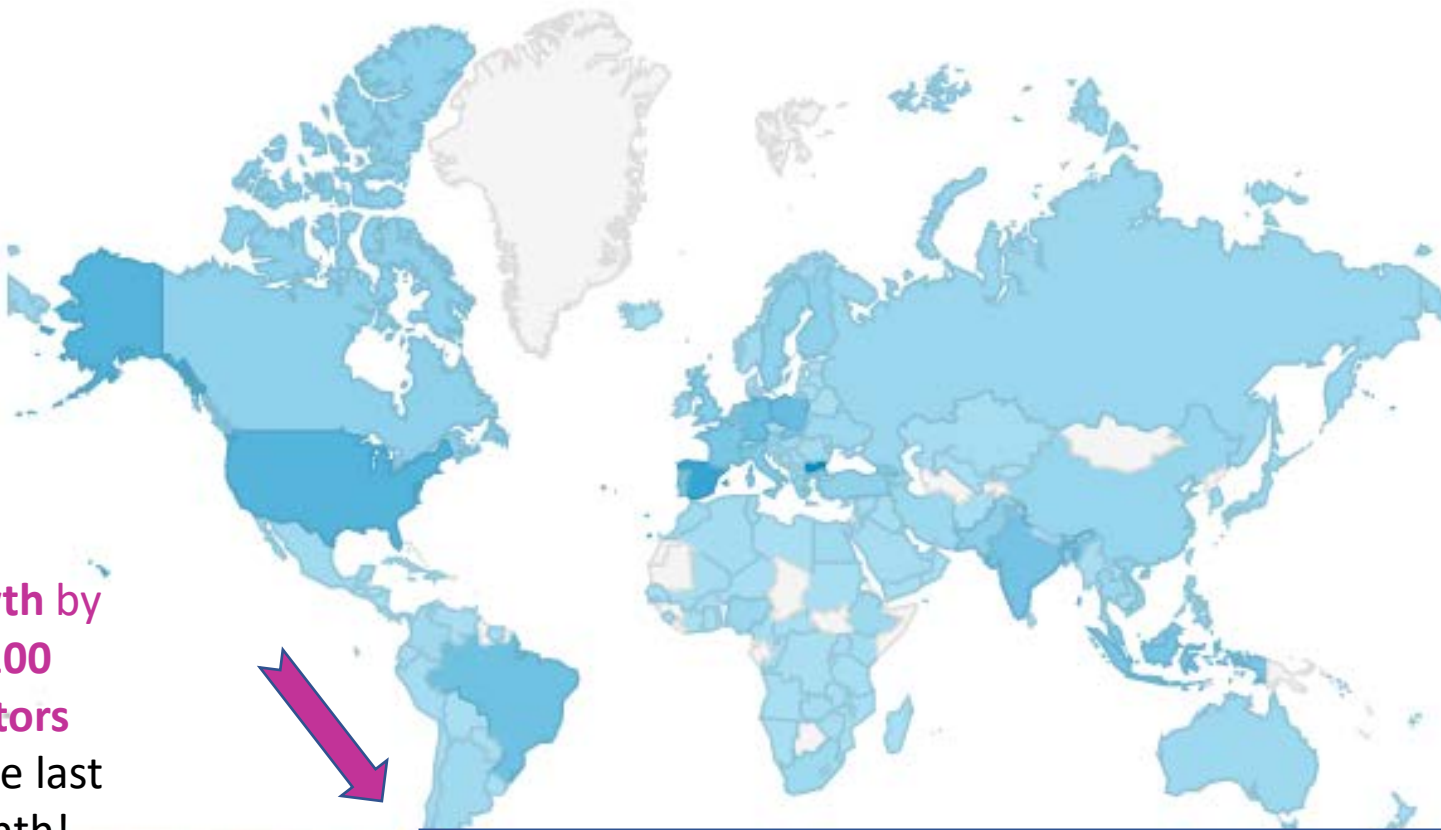

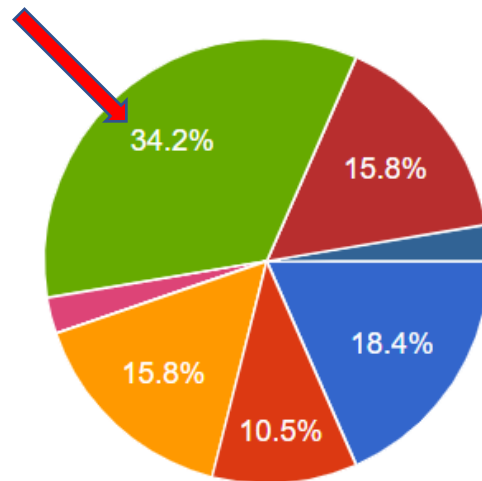
